## 1. Password Protection (General Overview)

The engine control module (ECM) allows the vehicle to be configured to help the owner optimize fuel economy and reliability. The password protection feature provides protection to prevent unauthorized users from changing parameter values in the ECM.

This document will describe the Password Protection feature for International® MaxxForce™ 11 and 13 engines.

## 3. Description and Operation

The owner/operator may desire a certain vehicle configuration including specific parameters. They may also desire additional security to prevent unauthorized users from changing these parameters in the ECM.

The password protection feature can be used to lock the features. With the password set, the service tool will prompt for the current password and not allow any parameter to be changed until that password is entered.

### 3.1. Operation

When changing a customer configurable parameter (“Y” in “Customer Programmable” column) the password feature will protect the parameter from changing without the password.

**NOTE:** The ServiceMaxx electronic service tool will only prompt for the password if one has been set by the customer.

The following programmable parameter is used for setting the password on this application.
